General and Emergency Assistance

We understand you may be in a difficult situation, and there are many resources available to you, Lemont Township for General or Emergency Assistance should be your last stop. Lemont Township wants to help, but we are only able to assist so much, and your current hardship may be more than we are able to assist you with. We want to ensure you are utilizing all available resources to you. Before applying for General or Emergency Assistance, have you applied for the following programs?

If you need Rental Assistance, have you contacted the Homeless Prevention Hotline?

If no, please call 1-877-426-6515. They will complete an assessment with you and try to partner you with an agency that has available rental assistance. It is best to contact them at 8:30AM, right when the call center opens. Please note: There may be additional rental assistance programs available.

If yes, what was the result, when did you call?
If you need Gas, Electric or Water Bill Assistance, have you applied for LIHEAP, or LIWEAP? They are a part of CEDA which is a Community Partner Agency that assists residents with a one-time a year grant for Gas, Electric, and/or Water Bills?
If no, please contact Lemont Township at 630-257-252 to schedule an appointment for LIHEAP assistance, or we can refer you to an agency that is currently taking applications.
If yes, what was the result, when did you apply?
If you have already for LIHEAP or do not qualify for LIHEAP, and need additional Gas Bill assistance, have you applied for Nicor Sharing Program? They are a partnership with the Salvation Army.
If no, please contact Lemont Township at 630-257-2522 to schedule an appointment for Nicor Sharing Assistance.

If you recently lost your job, have you applied for Unemployment Benefits through IDES?
